To our dear friends and supporters,

As we sincerely seek to gain a higher understanding of Truth and listen for God's direction, Mrs. Eddy assures us that "Each successive stage of experience unfolds new views of divine goodness and love."

This is what the Wellsprings Board has been witnessing these past seven months since our facility closed. Each stage of demonstration has unfolded a new path. We found an assisted living organization eager to love our facility as much as we did, and closed on the sale of the property to them on Wednesday, August 21; held an open strategic planning session in May to answer questions and listen to ideas with those who expressed interest in helping us actively move forward; had a wonderful lunch with some of the nurses to hear their needs; and, have been establishing a new direction in which to directly support the availability of Christian Science nursing.

Under the terms of the sale, Wellsprings immediately received sufficient funds to discharge nearly all our financial obligations to creditors, and relieved us from the financial burden of maintaining the facility. We also receive a short-term income stream that will allow us to begin a new operational approach.

Waiting for the Apopka transaction to be completed, we began to determine our next tasks, incorporating the ideas gained from our meetings. They are:

1. **Educate** members of our churches on the value of Christian Science nursing and its impact on the speedy recovery of those under Christian Science treatment.
2. **Assist** nurses in the development of their individual Christian Science nursing practice and ministry.
3. **Support** and **enable** benevolent assistance for those using Christian Science nursing services.

We are establishing a part time Community Coordinator position to help assess needs in communities; be the point of contact for nurses, churches, and practitioners; help those in need find qualified, available nurses, and assisting them in obtaining necessary supplies and equipment. We are also maintaining the Wellsprings phone number.

The Board sends a heartfelt thanks to each one of you for your patience and financial support provided us this past year. We are eager to implement these new steps, and welcome all to contact us with ideas and questions.
